Kazakhstan National University Testing,	with a minimum score of 90 out of 120.
ACT (American College Test) examination,	a minimum score of 21 in Math , Science Reasoning and total score.
TAWJIHI examinations given in Jordan and Palestine, in the Scientific Stream,	a minimum average of 80 points in all courses.
SAT I examination,	a minimum score of 1000 out of 1600 in Reasoning Test, Math and Critical Reading and a minimum score of 500 out of 800 in Math.
GCE (General Certificate Education / A Level Certificate),	A level in at least two subjects, at least one of which is related to the program applied for.
Baccalauréat Libanais examination given in Lebanon,	with a diploma score of at least 13 in Scientific Stream.
International Baccalaureate	with a diploma score of at least 28.
Diplôme Debirestan ve Pişdeneşgahi,	with a high school diploma score of at least 17 out of 20 (Diplome Debirestan) and with a minimum score of 17 out of 20 in Pişdeneşgahi diploma score.
ABITUR examination (German Baccalaureate),	with a minimum score of 4.

Gaokao Examination given in China,	with a minimum score of 500 out of 750 in the area related to the program applied for.
Al-Shahada-Al Thanawiyya (Baccalaureate) examination, in the Scientific Stream,	with a minimum score of 200 out of 240 for Medical Faculty, 190 out of 240 for Faculty of Engineering and Architecture, 175 out of 240 for other programs.
University Entrance Examination of Azerbaijan (TQDK),	a minimum score of 200 out of 700 in the area of specialization related to the program applied for.
French Baccalaureate,	with a diploma score of at least 12.
University Entrance Examination of Greece	with a minimum of 40 percent of total score
