

**REQUIRED DOCUMENTS AND PROVISIONS
FOR STUDENT VISA IN TURKEY**

a) Students who are accepted to the higher education institutions in our country:

Starting from 2012, TCS (Exam of Turkish Republics and Turkish and Relative Groups) was abolished and from now on our higher education institutions choose international students on their own. Personal application to our Consulate Branch is compulsory. Visa application is accepted in the same day and it can be issued in the same day or within a few days depending on the work load.

Required documents and provisions:

- Original copy of the approval or invitation document to the university in our country,
- Original copy of high school diploma or its copy approved by our education consultancy,
- Passport,
- Identity card,
- 2 passport photographs (3x4),
- Financial document about the income of the family (payroll sheet or bank account).
- Students under the age of 18 must submit the Deed of Consent.

b) Students who are accepted to private or state universities in our country:

Personal application to our Consulate Branch is compulsory.

Required documents and provisions:

- Agreement with the universities to which the student is accepted,
- Invitation,
- Invitation letter from the relevant universities addressing our Embassy,
- If the education is paid, bill of payment regarding education charges,
- Original copy and photo copy of high school diploma,
- Passport,
- Identity card,
- 2 passport photographs (3x4),
- Financial document about the income of the family (payroll sheet or bank account).

c) Students who are accepted to exchange programmes in accordance with the Protocol signed between the local universities and the universities in our country:

Personal application to our Consulate Branch is compulsory.

Required documents and provisions:

-Invitation letter from the universities to which the student is accepted, addressing our Embassy,

-Protocol signed between the aforementioned universities (Turkish version or any photo copy in the local language),

-If the education is paid, bill of payment regarding education charges,

- Student certificate from the university, where the students is studying, addressing our Embassy,

- Passport,

- Identity card,

- 2 passport photographs (3x4),

- Financial document about the income of the family (payroll sheet or bank account).

d) Students who are accepted to TÖMER (Center of Turkish Learning) education institutions in our country:

Personal application to our Consulate Branch is compulsory. Visas can be issued after negotiating with the Police Department.

Required documents and provisions:

- Agreement with TÖMER to which the student is accepted,

- Invitation,

- Bill of payment regarding education charges,

- Original copy and photo copy of high school diploma,

- Passport,

- Identity card,

- 2 passport photographs (3x4),

- Financial document about the income of the family (payroll sheet or bank account).

e) Students who are accepted to Turkish language courses in our country:

Personal application to our Consulate Branch is compulsory. Visas can be issued after negotiating with the Police Department.

Required documents and provisions:

- Agreement with the education institution to which the student is accepted,

- Invitation, bill of payment regarding education charges,

- Original copy and photo copy of the diploma from the school the student has recently graduated,

- Passport,

- Identity card,

- 2 passport photographs (3x4),

- Financial document about the income of the family (payroll sheet or bank account).

f) Students who are accepted to any course other than Turkish language courses in our country:

Personal application to our Consulate Branch is compulsory. Visas can be issued after negotiating with the Police Department.

Required documents and provisions:

- Agreement with the education institution to which the student is accepted,
- Invitation,
- Bill of payment regarding education charges,
- Original copy and photo copy of the diploma from the school the student has recently graduated,
- Passport,
- Identity card,
- 2 passport photographs (3x4),
- Financial document about the income of the family (payroll sheet or bank account).

g) Students who will study in Religious Vocational High Schools or Koran Courses of the Department of Religious Affairs in our country:

Personal application to our Consulate Branch is compulsory. Visas can be issued after negotiating with the Police Department. For students who are accepted by the Department of Religious Affairs and whose names are submitted to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, visas are issued without any negotiation.

Required documents and provisions:

- Invitation letter from the high school or Koran Course to which the student is accepted, addressing our Embassy,
- Approval document from the Office of Mufti, where the student is registered,
- Original copy and photo copy of the diploma from the school where the student has recently graduated,
- Passport,
- Identity card,
- 2 passport photographs (3x4),
- Financial document about the income of the family (payroll sheet or bank account).

h) Students who will study in our country within the frame of AIESEC (Turkish Association of Internship Committee for Students of Economics and Commercial Sciences)

Personal application to our Consulate Branch is compulsory. Visa application is accepted in the same day and it can be issued in the same day or within a few days depending on the work load.

- Invitation letter from AIESEC programme to which the students is accepted, addressing our Embassy,
- Letter of Permit from the company or education institution where the student is currently working, if any.
- Original copy and photo copy of the diploma from the school where the student has recently graduated,
- Passport,
- Identity card,
- 2 passport photographs (3x4),
- Financial document about the income of the family (payroll sheet or bank account).
